Matters arising	Letter has been sent to Aled Davies, who requested to build on the Pennant land. Public Conveniences Cllr Irfon Jones said that the facilities will not close at short notice. It was asked if the Council would be willing to discuss other options such as: reducing the hours of the caretaker, keep only two toilets open? County Council have not kept to the original agreement to leave a key to the facilities with Llanpumsaint Council. If the toilets were to close, would Llanpumsaint be allowed to keep the key? Councillors' opinions on keeping the Conveniences: The responsibility could be a bottomless financial pit. Many in the community do not benefit from the facilities, why pay more precept to pay for a service that does not benefit the whole community. The next meeting will be the Annual Meeting; an opportunity for the community to listen to discussions. Malcolm Howells reminded the council that member of the community are not allowed to talk, but listen only.
