Matters arising

The kiosks are now in the process of being adopted waiting to hear back from BT.

To enquire with Steve Lee the results of the monitoring of speeding traffic through the village.

To contact with Nigel Francis to discuss the cost of the street lamps and how to save energy at night.

Correspondence.

A letter received from the county council with the possibility of the community council to take over the public toilets in the village. The annual breakdown of £7,000 pounds meant that the council would have to double the village's precept. This was discussed and unanimously rejected a letter from the clerk to be sent.

Financial matters

The audit commission have completed the annual return for the end of March 2010 and the council to accept and the chair to date and sign before it is sent back to the auditor.

Any other matters

There are still outstanding issues with regard to the road surfaces near Betws, Pantour and Pantydriw. There is a need for a grit box in Maenllwyd and also there is water running freely and not reaching the drains.

There have been complaints brought to the attention of the council with regard to the cut of water supplies to the village. There was a promise of bottled water to residents of the village and this was not delivered to a high number. Clerk to send our comments on to Welsh Water.

Public footpath 26/9 sign has been damaged to contact Eirian James.

Planning application to measure electricity on Nantygelli farm land has not been presented to our council and as it borders on our parish C Smethurst felt that it should have been. The council's comments will be sent to the planning office by the clerk.
