Cables to be supported between two wooden poles 12 – 14 m high and erected close to woodland as camouflage stipulated Planning Dept. Councillors were unanimous that cable burial is the best option long term. Council opinion to be submitted to Planning by September. One Voice Wales requested nominations for represent the CC at regional meetings – CC suggested that whoever was available would attend.</p>
