Matters Arising	<p><b>Sewage.</b> Clerk recounted conversation with John Manley, Public Health Officer regarding sewer problems at Gwili Terrace. Clerk to contact JM again and request an update on discussions between Welsh Water and Carmarthen County Council</p> <p><b>CS</b> had contacted Richard Davies, CCC Officer with responsibility for monitoring and maintaining Sewers. RD reported that two additional pumps had been installed to speed up the flow of material through the sewer. A broken sewer pipe was discovered behind Gwili Terrace. Welsh Water have engaged a Consultant to assess the sewage network. RD will collate information and is available to address the Community Council of developments.</p> <p><b>Salt and Road Grit.</b> Clerk to contact Highways and request an additional Salt Box to be placed near Cwmwernen. The Salt Box near Maenllwyd only holds sufficient to grit the incline from Maenllwyd down to Onllwyn.</p> <p><b>The road sign</b> near the Railway Bridge needs a more permanent repair</p> <p><b>John McEvoy.</b> Has met with MH, CS and WT at the junction near Ty Nant and discussed the offending bush as well as modifying the road speed past the School and Playing Field.</p> <p><b>Western Power.</b> An invitation for all to attend a Consultation Meeting</p> <p><b>WT;</b> recently there has been mention that at least some of the cables will be placed underground. Concern about the increasing voltage in the cables passing Pont ar Sais as current from the numerous wind farms is connected.</p> <p><b>AN;</b> does the Community want the cabling to be situated as close?</p> <p><b>WT;</b> the original decision was to reject them; financial compensation shouldn't be the enticement.</p>
