Bu **Adfer Parcdir Godidog** yn gynllun pum mlynedd i ail greu tirwedd hanesyddol gwaith William Paxton yn y 18fed a'r 19eg ganrif, nawr dan yr enw Gwarchodle Cenedlaethol Natur Waun Las. 'Roedd y parcdir yn enghraifft cynnar o ddelfydau darluniadwy i gyfleu dyluniad tirwedd drwy gyfleu cyferbyniadau natur – ar un eiliad o dawelwch godidog a'r nesa holl gynnwrf dwr yn rhaeadru dros gored a sgwd. Gallwn weld 6 o'r 15 llun greuwyd gan Thomas Horner ar gais William Paxton o wahannol safleoedd ar draws yr ystad yn 1815. Mae manylder y lluniau o'r tirwedd a'r llynnoedd wedi cyflwyno cyfoeth o wybodaeth i'r cynllunwyr a'r peirianwyr wrth ail greu.

Dros y ddwy flynedd a hanner ddiwethaf bu'r safle'n gynnwrf o brysurdeb. Galluogodd Haf cynnes 2018 i beriannau mawr symud 22,000m o laid allan o Lyn Mawr, a fu'n cronni yno ers degawdau. Yna symudwyd clai o'r pyllau cyfagos i greu argae gan eu wasgu gan beiriant arbennig. Yn ol yn nyddiau Paxton byddai rhaid gwneud y gwaith hyn drwy whilbero a defnyddio traed defaid – dyna pam yr enwyd y peiriant presennol ar ol yr anifael. Profwyd pob haen o'r cywasgiad gan beiriant technegol i sicrhau i'r argae gydymffurfio a gofynion mawl Y Ddedf Argae. Mae Llyn Mawr yn un o'r mwyaf yn y Gerddi – dros 65,000m mewn maint, felly deirgwaith yn fwy na'r llynnoedd eraill i gyd. 350m yw ei hyd gyda thair gorlifan i fwydo'r argae. Defnyddir Gorlifan 1 at ddebenion pob dydd gyda'r ddwy arall wedi ei cynllunio i ymateb i orlifo.

Trawsnewidiwyd Llyn Felin Gat hefyd gyda rhaeadr nauriol wedi ei chreu gan gored hir. Bydd pont wladaidd yn rhedeg dros yr ored, lle gall ymwelwyr sefyll uwchben llif y dwr. Bu Selwyn Jones Saer Maen talentog y fenter yn hanfodol i'r cynllun Adfer, yn gyfrifol am ail greu'r bont hanesyddol, gorlifan Llyn Mawr, y muriau a'r rhaeadr. Er mwyn iddo weithio ar y rhaeadr bu'n rhaid gosod scaffaldd arbennig gan arallgyfeirio llif y dwr gyda phibell i ochr y sgwd. Awgryma llun Thomas Horner i'r bont fod yn hongian yn yr awyr, ond fydd yr un bresennol yn sicr o ddiogel.

Bydd yna chwe phont i gydlynnu'r cerdded drwy'r tirwedd mewn cylch. Lluniwyd y ddwy bont ddur gan Gwmni Peirianeg Afon yn Abertawe a'u gosod yn eu lle yn Awst 2019. Daeth y pedair pont arall yn ystod Haf 2020.

Mae'r llwybrau cerdded yn rhan hanfodol o'r cynllun. Braidd yn ddinod efallai ond maent yn cydlunnu'r holl wynepryd gan dywys yr ymwelydd drwy'r tirwedd. Creuwyd llwybr newydd drwy Goedwig y Tylwyth Teg, gan eich tywys heibio'r Tai Tylwyth a'r bwyd y boda, i ddatgelu golygfa bellenig o llyn Mawr a'r tirwedd draw. Mae yna safle gwyllo, cuddiedig ers canrif yno i arddangos maint Llyn Mawr, y ddwy bont ddur a'r argae ysblenydd.

Edrychwn ymlaen at ail groesawu ymwelwyr yma i'r Gerddi yn 2021. Oherwydd ansicrwydd y sefyllfa bresennol ni wyddom pan fydd hynny, ond mi fydd y Parcdir Adferol ar agor bryd hynny. Edrychwn ymlaen at eich croesawi i weld ein cynllun newydd.

Mae ein Parcdir Godidog a'r llynnoedd yn ymestyn dros ardal eang gyda'r llwybrau newydd yn filltiroedd o hyd. Mae angen Ceidwadwyr i ofalu amdanynt yn rheolaidd, gan fod yn weladwy i'r ymwelwyr, i ymateb i ymholiadau neu gais am gymorth o ryw fath.



If anyone has a cardiac arrest the sooner CPR is given and defib used, the more likely the patient will survive. Every minute is important, and the ambulance service will help you do this on the phone until the first responder arrives. This may be the local fire service who have been trained to do this. They will stay until the ambulance arrives.

If you are not sure about using a defibrillator, you can borrow a training pack from me to show you and the family how to give CPR and how to use the defibrillator. Although none of the village defibrillators have been used, you never know when you might need to help, so just going through the process with a training pack may help you and your family save a life. About Broadband Universal Service

Do you have a broadband speed of less than 10mbs?

BT is working with Ofcom, the independent communications regulator, to deliver the broadband universal service obligation (USO). It's a piece of government legislation that gives eligible UK addresses the right to request a 'decent' broadband connection.

What happens next?

Call BT/Openreach dedicated helpdesk on 0800 783 0223 to get started. They'll confirm whether your address is eligible. This may take up to 30 days.

A decent connection is one that can deliver a download speed of at least 10Mb and an upload speed of at least 1Mb. Affordable means it doesn't cost more than £46.10 a month. Most people will be able to choose a service costing much less than this though.

Why was this minimum speed chosen?

It was set by the Government in March 2018. Ofcom research shows that 10Mb is the minimum speed currently needed to meet an average household's digital needs. It should be fast enough for multiple people in a household to be online at once.

Will I have to pay anything? It depends on how much the work to upgrade your local network will cost.

If the total cost is £3,400 or less (exclusive of VAT) you won't have to pay for the work to be done.

If it's higher than that, you can still get a connection as long as you're eligible but you'll need to pay the excess cost.

If this happens we'll provide a quote so you can decide what to do.

And at least one person in the village now has fibre to the premises as a result of contacting this number – so give it a try.

Botanic Garden News

The Regency Restoration was a five-year project which has restored features of a Regency period landscape, created in the late 18th and early 19th century for William Paxton, in what is now Waun Las National Nature Reserve.

The parklands were an early example of Picturesque ideals being utilised in landscape design, characterised by the contrasts that nature can show – at one moment, beautiful tranquillity, and at the next the drama of tumbling water over cascades, a weir, and waterfall. We have access to six of the fifteen paintings by Thomas Hornor who was invited by William Paxton to paint a series of viewpoints throughout the estate in 1815. The intricate details in these paintings of the parkland and lakes have provided the designers and engineers with a wealth of information on which plans for the restoration were based.

Over the last two and a half years, the restoration site has been a hive of activity. The very warm summer of 2018 bore witness to large machines undertaking the mammoth task of removing 22,000m³ of silt from Llyn Mawr which had built up over the preceding decades. Clay was then extracted from borrow pits within the adjacent fields to create the dam and this was compacted with a machine called a pad foot or sheep's foot roller. During Paxton's time this compaction would have been carried out by families using wheelbarrows and flocks of sheep – hence the modern machine's name. Each layer of compaction was tested with geotechnical tools, to ensure the dam would meet stringent Reservoir Act requirements. Llyn Mawr is one of the largest lakes at the Botanic Garden – over 65,000m³ in size, that's nearly three times bigger than the existing lakes combined! The dam is 350m long, and has three spillways to take water over the dam. Spillway one is used in everyday conditions, while the other two are engineered to cope with bigger floods.

Llyn Felin Gat was also transformed, with a natural looking cascade created with a long weir. There will be a 'rustic' bridge running over the weir, so that visitors can stand with the water cascading beneath them. The project's talented heritage stonemason, Selwyn Jones, was instrumental in the restoration. He was responsible for the refurbishment of a Grade II listed bridge, Llyn Mawr's cascade (spillway one), the historic cascade walls at Llyn Felin Gat, and the waterfall. To enable Selwyn to work on this iconic waterfall, cantilevered scaffolding was erected which was quite a feat of engineering in itself and the water was diverted via a pipe to the side of the waterfall. In Thomas Hornor's painting the bridge looks somewhat suspended in mid-air but this definitely will not be the case with our new bridge, which is firmly fixed!

There are six bridges in total which link up and provide a series of walking circuits which snake through the landscape. The two steel bridges fabricated in Swansea by Afon Engineering were craned into place in August 2019. The four remaining bridges were installed during the summer of 2020.

One of the most important parts of the landscape restoration are the paths. They tend to go unnoticed, but provide the network that links the features, and draw visitors into the landscape. The project has seen a new path through Fairy Wood created that meanders past the fairy houses and toadstools, providing glimpses of Llyn Mawr and the parklands beyond. A viewing platform hidden for over a century gives you the opportunity to see and feel the vast scale of Llyn Mawr whilst also giving you look at the two steel bridges and the vast dam.

We are looking forward to welcoming visitors back to the Garden in 2021. Due to such uncertainty at the moment we are not sure of when this will be but when we do reopen the restoration site will be open! We are very much looking forward for you to wander amongst nature and be wowed by all the restored features which are around every corner.

This project has enriched the wider landscape to restore the stunning designed landscape for the pleasure of all our visitors.

We are looking for volunteers to patrol the area, following a set route, being a visible presence to our visitors and ensuring them that someone is always around who can help with any queries they may have or if they need help.

The Garden is open 7 days a week and we are looking for volunteers to undertake one time-slot per day, there are three time-slots per day available – 11am to 1pm, 1pm – 3pm and 3pm to 5pm.

More Scam News

At long last we are getting closer to getting back to a normal life - if you can remember what that was! However, don't get too complacent when making sure that you are not only keeping safe from Covid but also making sure that you don't get scammed in any way.

These nasty folk are still lurking in the background.

I've previously warned you that various organisations will never phone you, such as the Police, HMRC, the Bank, BT, Microsoft, etc. Also if you are asked to pay for a Covid jab, it's a scam.

Latest new one:-

People waiting for a parcel to arrive receive a text from "Royal Mail" saying that they have to pay £1.99 before the parcel will be delivered. They kindly provide a link to a site which is mocked up to look like Royal Mail.

"The page requests personal and payment details, which scammers may use to steal someone's identity, or use to target them with other scams.

Royal Mail said it would not use such texts - unless specifically requested - and would use a grey card instead to tell people if any fee was required."

My lovely Wife recently had a call on her mobile phone from HMRC saying that she had been found guilty of Tax Fraud and if she did not press 1 then someone was going to come round to arrest her. We are still waiting for them to knock on the door!

Finally, a date for your diaries. On the 13th April 2029 (Yes, Friday the 13th) an asteroid which has been called Apophis should pass the Earth at a distance of about 19,662 miles from the Earth's surface.

So, keep your eyes peeled, it should be visible without the use of telescopes or binoculars.

You may see this one coming, make sure you also see the scammers coming.

From Dyfed Powys Police SCAM WARNING

During a time where more and more people are grocery shopping online or using click and collect services, a number of you have reported to us that you've received scam calls from fraudsters pretending to be Tesco. The automated call states that your Tesco order has been placed and your account will be debited £350. The call goes on to say "if this is not the right amount, please press 1 to go through to our fraud team".

With this type of call, if '1' is pressed, the scammer will attempt to gain as many personal details as possible from you, including your bank details.

These are smart criminals who know what they're doing, and they will often appear genuine. If you receive a call like this, it's best to hang up and either check your Tesco online account yourself, or call Tesco directly from a number you have obtained.

You can help protect yourself from such scams by following this advice:

- Do not pass any personal or financial details to anyone who calls you out of the blue.
- Do not follow any links if the criminals text or email them through. These will take you to fake sites that are built to look authentic.
- Never accept or download any remote software to your computer that allows other people to access it.
- Do not sign into your bank account online if you have installed remote access software, otherwise there's a good chance you'll lose money.
- If someone on a cold call asks you to download a remote access app or access your bank account – end the call.
- If you have received a call like this, and you've accessed your account or transferred money – always contact your bank on the number on the back of your bank card. Never use a number you're given by the caller.
- Always remember to STOP-CHALLENGE-PROTECT

Warning - New domain pretending to be Microsoft could fool a lot of people!

The campaign has so far targeted over 200 million Microsoft Office 365 users, including those working in the financial services, healthcare, manufacturing, and utilities industries. Users receive an email, purportedly from Microsoft, to test a new feature of O365 which states that it allows them to reclaim emails mistakenly marked as spam. When the user clicks the link, however, they are redirected to a fake Microsoft portal which requests they enter their credentials, which are then harvested by the attacker.

This is a timely reminder to always be vigilant and always check the email address of the sender thoroughly.

Always check the domain of the sender carefully: **Micros0ft.com**, **MIicrosoft.com** and **Microsoft[.]com** are not Microsoft domains.

- If you are on a web page, look at the address in the URL bar – make sure it is the correct domain.
- If you have clicked on a link and entered user information and password, report it to IS&T
- Be extra vigilant when shopping online of fake shopping sites that have been made to look like the originals

A warm welcome for newcomers to the village.

Llampumsaint has been a very vibrant and active community in the past. Sadly the Covid lockdowns have curtailed just about all of those events, so here is some information on what we hope will recur when this awful time is over.

The Railway Inn has been an important focus for many events. Monthly Supper Club, Curry and Quiz night, Wednesday evening Steak night. On Christmas Eve we hold a Santa Parade. Santa is towed around the village in his sleigh by a tractor-driving elf. Children, more elves and grown-ups alike follow him collecting money and singing Christmas carols and seasonal songs. The parade culminates at the pub where a Santa Grotto gives a selection box to all of the children who have taken part in the parade. They also provided hot soup and mince pies for everyone.

In summer we hold a Fun Day in the village hall and field where you can pay for a table selling whatever you wish to provide. Drinks and cake is provided, there is a duck race on the river and a pig roast is provided in the evening. Money collected goes to charity.

The neighbouring village of Bronwydd also plays a big part with a Gardening club, Knitters club (my daft hubby always called it the Knutters club), an over 50s fitness club and a West Wales Dowers club. They also run a monthly Over 60s club. This club organises coach trips out, speakers to come into the hall and a fantastic annual Turkey and Tinsel event.

Other events take place occasionally such as organised walks, cawl nights, pancake fest bingo nights and there is a weekly mobile library and foot clinic.



The Ogham Stone

Despite all the modern developments Llanpumsaint village preserves much evidence of its past history. The derelict Farmers Co-op on the old station yard echoes the era of busy trains and family farms; once rhythmically noisy but now silent two factory buildings serve to remind of the heyday of the woollen industry, and hymns no longer burst forth out of the empty Bethel Chapel. Yet by far our oldest link to the past remains largely forgotten.

As you enter Llanpumsaint Church, a few yards beyond the Vestry door, pause to identify a small stone in amongst the gravestones on your left-hand side. There lies the Ogham Stone, by far our oldest link to Llanpumsaint's past, dated to between the 7th and 9th century by Nash Williams in his Early Christian Monuments of Wales. Placed here to commemorate an ancient hero on a site which by then was a functioning Church serving the local community. That original Celtic Church would have been of wood erected on a site previously sacred to the Druids as were the Pools and waterfall way above. In accordance with ancient tradition the building had been carefully sited in a defensive V formed by the Gwili and Cerwyn rivers, to keep the evil spirits at bay.

The cross on the stone is clearly visible but if one examines the Ogham Stone very carefully a series of faint notches can just be discerned here and there, to reveal vital evidence. This is the ancient Ogham Irish script form of writing, revealing that around then there were a lot of Irish people in Llanpumsaint as some place-names like Cnwc also reveal. Brythonic Welsh, Irish and Latin would have echoed around here then. So send someone a card using the script below. *Arwyn 2021*
