Wythnosau yn ól dechreuaus i sgwrsio a Noel Kirkpatrick o gwmni B.T. Mae'r cebl ffibr wedi bod tu allan i'r tú mewn bocs gwyrdd newydd ers peth amser yn awr.

Ro'n i eisioes wedi gwirio statws y ffibr ac nid oedd unrhyw symudiad wedi digwydd ers amser maith. Dwedodd Noel nad oedd "Open Reach" wedi newid y statws ers peth amser a byddai rhaid aros am fis eto cyn y byddai archebu yn bosibl. Rhaid diolch i Noel am ddod yn ól ata i mewn 5 diwrnod bob tro y byddai yn gwenud unrhyw ymholiadau ac mae e wedi poeni Openreach am ddyddiad yn ól ei addewid. Pan gafodd Llanpumsaint bandlydan cyflymach rhai blynnyddoedd yn ól fe wnaeth y cynllun stopio ar bwys yr arwyddbost(ar waelod yr heol) gan ein bod ni sef 32 o dai ddim o fewn cyffiniau'r pentref. Felly roedd rhaid bodloni ar 2 Mbs. Gyda chymorth y Llywodraeth cafwyd grant ac yn y diwedd fe gaethon ni 10 Mpbs. Mae yn cael ei drosglwyddo drwy radio a hynny o fastiau sydd o amgylch yr ardal. Mae hwn gyda ni ers sawl blwyddyn bellach ac y mae yn awr yn dechrau rhoi problemau i ni a hynny yn waeth yn yr haf gyda'r tyfiant sydd ar y coed.Yn bresennol mae gyda ni rhwng 2 a 6 Mbps. Ychydig wythnosau yn ól gwiriaisiau eto i weld a byddai y ffibr ar gael i ni yn y rhan yma o'r pentref ond doedd dim symudiad wedi bod o gwbl.

Ar Orffenaf 14eg roedd contractwyr ar yr heol yma yn gwirio y cysylltiadau yn y bocs gwyrdd sydd ar y post.(fel sydd yn rhannau eraill o'r pentref) felly ar Orffenaf 16eg gwiriaisiau eto gyda BT ac yr oedd popeth yn barod i archebu. Roedden ni yn y rhan yma o'r pentref o'r diwedd yn mynd i gael 300Mbps!!!!

Felly yn syth fe archebais i "BT Infinity" achos ein bod yn awr yn cael cadarnhad y byddwn yn cael y 52Mb. gwaranteedig.

Mae'r sefydlu mewn dau ran fel a ganlyn:-

Rhan 1 Bydd Open Reach yn rhoi bocs gwyn ar y wal tu fás i'r tú ac yn cysylltu y ffibr iddo. Maent yn dweud nid yw yn ofynnol i chi aros gartref pan fyddant yn cysylltu'r bocs ond falle byddai yn ddoeth i wneud.

Y dyddiad penodol i ni oedd Gorffenaf 26ain ond fe gyrhaeddodd y peirianwyr ar fore y 25ain – diolch byth ein bod gartref. Yn ól y peirianwyr roedd y cyfarwyddiadau ar y bocs yn gamarweiniol a byddai yn well ganddynt petasai un o ni adref er mwyn trafod ble oedd y bocs gwyn i fod ar y wal.

Ar ól tipyn o drafod, yn lle llawer o wifrau ar y wal, fe ddaethont i benderfyniad y byddai y ffibr yn cael ei sefydlu yn y bocs bach gwyn yn ein llofft. A thrwy hyn byddai yn hawdd i BT ei gyrraedd pan fyddant ar eu hymweliad nesaf. Mae'n rhyfedd cyn lleied yw'r ffibr.

Roedd BT wedi trefnu ymwelaid ar Awst 1af i orffen y gwaith ac yn y cyfamser fe gyrhaeddodd y "router" drwy'r post. Felly roedd popeth yn barod.

Ar Awst 1af roedd BT fod gyrraedd rhwng 8.00 y b. a 1.00 y.p. Doedd neb wedi cyrraedd am 12.15 y.p. gwiriaisiau eto i weld beth oedd y sefyllfa. Gwaetha'r modd yr ateb oedd na fyddai y peirianwr yn dod achos bod problem gyda'r ffibr newydd!

Rhoddwyd cinio anrhydeddus iddo yn y Railwe , gyda thystysgrif o werthfawrogiad ganaelodau'r Cyngor Yn ei swydd gyntaf profodd fwrlwm y marts wrth iddo weithio i John Francis am naw mlynedd, cyn mentro i agor Siop y Pentan gydag Eurig Wyn a Wil Lloyd, yn 1972. Ac yno y bu hyd ei ymddeoliad yn 2009. Ar wahân i werthu cynnrych Cymreig bu Wyn yn llais cryf dros hawliau pobl y farchnad. Death hefyd yn wyneb cyfarwydd ar y sgrin pan oedd angen siarad dros yr iaith a'r diwylliant Cymraeg. A hyn i gyd cyn symud i'r dre ac ymuno a'r Cyngor yno. Felly gwir y gair pan gychwynnodd, "*S'dim ishe cyflwyno'r Maer newydd! Chi gyd yn i nabod e!*".

Gyda llu o brofiadau newydd fel ton ar ol ton, rheolwyd y dyddiadur yn ddiogel gan Ysgrifenyddes brofiadol y Maer Eleri James. "*Cefais fy synnu gan y croeso cynnes ymhob man, ac yn arbennig ymateb brwdfrydig plant yr ysgolion i'r Maer!*" Bu ymgrych Elusen Y Maer yn llwyddiant unwaith eto gyda dros £4,000 wedi ei ddosbarthu i 15 elusen leol, a thalodd Wyn deyrnged i'r holl wirfoddolwyr yn y maes. Barnwyd Goleuadau Nadolig y Dre "*Gyda'r gorau yn y gorllewin!*"

Daeth nifer o ddigwyddiadau cadarnhaol i'r amlwg adeg ei flwyddyn, sef, trosglwyddo'r Guildhall i ddwylo'r Cyngor Sir, adnewyddu'r hen ysbtyt Prior, agor Cartref Cynnes, adnewyddu Melodrom y Parc a datblygiadau S4C i'r Egin. Bu'n falch i weld dathliadau Dydd Gŵyl Dewi'n ffynnu ac wrth gwrs parhad ym mhoblogrwydd Ras y Maer, gyda 770 yn cystadlu eleni. Gwnaed elw 0 £7,200.

Daeth pobl o Lesneven i Barlwr y Maer am y 35 blwyddyn yn olynol. Ond gwelwyd ef yn teithio allan hefyd i ddathliadau sawl Maer arall; i Hwlfordd, i Gydweli, ac i Lanelli (Maer y Dre a'r Maer Gwledig yno), a bu raid iddo godi'n gynnariawn er mwyn blasu Brecwast y Porthfaer yn Lacharn.

O hyn oll yr hyn wnaeth fwyaf o argraff arno fu ei ymweliad ag Ysgolion Myrddin a Q.E, i weld ymdrechion dewr y plant yno i lwyddo yn eu Sioeau Nadolig er eu holl anhawsderau, "*Pob un yn cael cyfle.....a gwneud eu gorau glas...yn tynnu dŵr o'ch llyged....S'o ni'n gwibod mor lwcus i ni!*"

Ar wahân i fwynhau'r profiad syndod i Wyn fu gweld enw Brian Wharton ymysg rhestr y Commodores yng Nghlanffferi. Dyn fu'n Landlord Tafarn y Railwe un adeg!

Y farn gyffredinol yw iddo fod yn Faer hynod o boblogaidd a llwyddiannus, yn nabod a chymysgu a phawb. Braff oedd clywed y Neges Ewillys Da eleni yn y Clos Mawr mewn Cymraeg a Saesneg mor raenus. Lle bynnag yr oedd ar ei draed cadwedd at roi' neges yn hwylus ddwyieithog, gan ennyn edmygedd a gosod esiampl. Bu *Rheg i'r Maer ar ben rhwng Alltwalis* yn ymadrodd lleol poblogaidd yn ardal Pencader adeg y ganrif ddiwethaf, yn nodi arferiad rhai i feirniadu o bellter saff. Yn bendant chlywch chi neb yn beirniadu'r Maer hwn o unrhyw dyle na phellter. Felly mae'n llawn haeddu cael ei dderbyn i'r Orsedd yn Eisteddfod Genedlaethol Sir Fôn eleni.

BT Fibre Optic Broadband – one resident's story

A few weeks ago, I started chatting to Noel Kirkpatrick from the BT Executive Level Technical Complaints /CS Directors Team. The fibre cable has been on the post in the new green box outside the house for quite some time. I had previously checked the status of fibre online and it had not moved for ages. Noel said that Openreach had not changed the status of the plan for ages and it was still saying 1 month before ordering was possible. To be fair to him, he has always got back to me within the 5 working days he promised and has kept on chasing Openreach for a proper update. Thanks Noel.

Remember that when BT put in faster BB to the whole of not-spot Llanpumsaint, years ago, they stopped at the signpost and said that “we” – more than 32 houses up here – were not included as we were “outside” the village. So, we were left with well under 2Mbs.

We eventually went for Resq – aided by a Welsh Government grant - which was the only option available to us. Unlimited downloads and capped at 10 Mbps. It's wireless, transmitted to us over the airwaves via masts situated around the region. We've had that for a few years but it's now giving us problems, due to the growth of trees, especially during the summer months. Currently between 2 and 6 Mbps.

A couple of weeks ago, I checked to see if fibre was available up here in the sticks – still no movement. On the 14th July, there were some contractors on our lane checking the connections in the green box on the posts so, on the 16th, I checked the BT checker site again and it was ready to order.

We can get 300Mbs !!!! Not needing that, on the 16th July, I ordered BT Infinity 1 and as we can get the max we are guaranteed 52Mb. The installation is in 2 stages.

Stage 1 is when Open Reach fit a white box to the wall of your house and fit the fibre to it. Their instructions state that you do not have to be present but you may be. Our date for this stage was the 26th July. They actually turned up on the morning of the 25th – luckily we were at home. The guys said that the instructions were misleading and that they preferred that someone was at home as they would always like to discuss the siting of the white box.

After a lot of discussions, instead of the intended messy wires on the wall, they came up with an easy and neat plan and the fibre was fitted directly into our loft with the white box, easily accessible for the next visit by BT. Fascinating to watch how the fibre gets into the house – and you would not believe how small it is, I have a sample.

BT were scheduled to visit on the 1st August to get the system up and ready. In the meantime, the router was delivered by Royal Mail on the 25th July as planned.

1st August, BT due between 8am and 1pm, had not arrived by 12:15 so checked online on the “track my order” page. Engineer confirmed changed to engineer confirmed NA So what does NA mean. Rang BT and was told engineer not coming as there was still a fault on our new fibre line!

5 e-mails and updates on their system confirming date and time but not a one saying it was not going to happen. Will update me in 2 days – Thursday the 3rd Aug. Really annoyed and disappointed.

But we're now looking forward to trying out the extras we get, BT Hotspots (which I've used in the past) and BT Smart Talk. We're not the first to get this service and we won't be the last. Lets hope that in the future, the Village will be known as a hot spot instead of a not spot. Enjoy!

Electrical storms and lightning strikes - How to protect yourselves.

Having heard about the devastating damage caused by the storms of June and more recently to a resident's electrical property, I thought I would let you know of our experiences. We are connected to the broadband network via wireless, beamed to us via several masts around the region. During the storm in June, some of these masts were put out of action, we were also out of action, but only because of outside equipment, nothing inside our house was affected.

For over 15 years, we have used Belkin Surge Protectors. They protect electrical equipment attached to them. They are guaranteed for life. We have them fitted to TV and Hi-fi systems and PC equipment. Since fitting them, we have had only 2 occasions where a power surge from the National Grid and another caused by a lightning strike, have put them out of action. On both occasions, no internal equipment in the house was damaged, the surge protectors were replaced, under warranty, free of charge and post free, no fuss. I have no affiliation with any such products, they just do what they say on the box. They cost very little, certainly less than the cost and inconvenience caused by electrical problems from such storms etc. I'm well aware of resident's recent losses but I hope this gives you some ideas to help protect your equipment in the future. This must, of necessity, be my final written word, in view of the recent announcement of a priest to serve full-time in the Parish of Llanpumsaint with Llanllawddog.

I was privileged to attend the Ordination in June at St. David's Cathedral, at which the Reverend Gaynor Jones-Higgs, together with a number of other candidates, received the laying on of hands by the Bishop. This ancient rite, I found, had lost none of its gravity during the many decades since my own ordination. My sincerest wishes to Rev. Gaynor as she prepares to meet her new challenge in your midst.

Not everyone is privileged to retire twice, but that honour will have fallen to me very shortly. Eighteen months ago, when I was invited to become your new Interim Minister, I never imagined that such a lengthy period lay ahead of me. It has, nevertheless, been a time when so many new friendships have been forged, and hopefully, my sharing of ministry with you in your three welcoming churches has been of some benefit. I have tried to get to know the area and people in general, though being non-resident has not helped in that respect. However, it has not been about me, but about you, as parishioners, churchgoers and non-churchgoers. I have sensed a feeling of community and togetherness, which is admirable, and the Church must continue to serve your three communities.

That said, the Church continues to change and evolve, as it has done over the centuries. The Bishop reminded us at her recent visitation, that traditional and familiar patterns of witnessing must inevitably give way to new initiatives. Ministry Areas, greater lay involvement and a readiness to be more flexible will be challenges for the future. I would appeal to those on the fringes of the Church to come in and work for the Kingdom of God. Our rural churches are not, and probably never have been, huge – but it is worth remembering, as a former colleague of mine used to say – “A satsuma is not a failed orange!” Work to your strengths and may God be with you.

I wish to thank you all for your fidelity, and especially the church officers and worship leaders for your unstinting service. In the words of the apostle Paul, “Finally, friends, farewell.....be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you”.

Community Council Roundup

Elections recently have created quite a stir; the Brexit Referendum result probably even flabbergasted Boris, the snap election outcome caused a Tory MP to conclude that they had shot themselves in the head but thankfully the County Elections passed without major change or controversy....or did they? Indeed, Irfon Jones was re-elected as our County Councillor but at Community Council level it wasn't the usual foregone conclusion that it would be 'business as usual' because completely unexpectedly, two Councillors did not stand for re-election, instead, they chose to retire! Wyn Thomas decided that after 43 years of being a Community Councillor, it was time to retire and during his announcement of intent, he thanked the Community Council for the valuable experiences received, which had fully prepared him to become a Councillor in Carmarthen. Carolyn Smethurst who had been a valuable contributor to Community Council affairs for 10 years also chose against re-election which left the Council which has 8 seats to be short of two; the winds of electoral change even swept around the small meeting room in the Memorial Hall! As there were two vacant seats and the County Elections had just passed, it was possible to co-opt new Councillors rather than hold a ballot, so in the July Council meeting, two new faces joined the existing Councillors; Gethin Edwards and Eirion Evans were welcomed by the Council Chair, Pamela Jones.

Matters recently discussed by the Councillors have been the poor adherence of traffic to the 20 mph restriction on the road passing the Playing Field; speeding motorists are most evident when there has been a road closure on the A485 and diverted traffic is re-routed passed the Memorial Hall. The Council have requested that the Road Safety Unit at the County Highways consider introducing impediments to traffic; although an inconvenience to all vehicles, voluntary adherence to the speed limit isn't happening therefore it shall have to be made mandatory.

Another application has been submitted to the County for funding to lay pavements for the safety of pedestrians and as a means to encourage more walkers to use the village as a means to exercise. Previous applications have been made but thus far, with no success; the most recent application will most probably be rejected but, 'if you don't ask, you don't get'!

Shortly, there will be a forum held which will include members of the community and Trustees from Skanda Vale, to discuss ways of reducing the impact that Temple visitors have on village life; sometimes, those that travel to our midst from afar to contemplate cause those that live locally to curse! Bhopal Still Matters

You may remember that in 1984, what is considered as the world's worst industrial accident happened in Bhopal, when methyl isocyanate and other chemicals leaked out from the Union Carbide Factory at Bhopal overnight on 2nd/3rd December 1984. Over 500,000 people living in shanty towns surrounding the plant were exposed to the leak of this highly toxic gas, and it is estimated that the immediate deaths were at least 4,000. No one knows how many were injured, some with lifelong effects, but it could be as high as 500,000.

The factory is still leaking poisonous chemicals to the surrounding area and water supplies, cancers are at levels much higher than should be expected, and over 1700 children still have congenital abnormalities. \$470m settlement in 1989 was inadequate to deal with the ongoing health problems the people are still suffering, over 32 years later. Despite ongoing legal action, Dow Chemical, who purchased Union Carbide, has maintained that all legal matters relating to the Bhopal disaster are closed!

But despite judicial prejudice, legal obstruction, government complicity and a vast inequality, Bhopal survivors have not given up, setting up a clinic 20 years ago to look after their own health needs, and 10 years ago, setting up a trust to rehabilitate the city's damaged children.

The determination, resilience and courage of the survivors provided the inspiration of a unique red rose 'Flame of Bhopal'. A Mayor for Llanpumsaint

Born and bred at Darfryn Llanpumsaint Wyn Thomas continued to live here during his working days before eventually retiring to Carmarthen. After spending 9 years following John Francis Auctioneers around the local marts and sales he embarked on a novel venture. In 1972 along with two other local lads, Will Lloyd and Eurig Wyn they risked opening Carmarthen's first Welsh Book Shop at the Market. The rest is history as Siop y Pentan became and continues to be a primary venue there; so to most people he became Wyn Pentan from here on.

Always a public figure Wyn became an ardent advocate in the 60's and 70's campaigns for language rights. He joined Llanpumsaint Community Council back in 1972 to retire only this year as his move to town became permanent. "*I can't remember how many times I was Chairman!*", but other members did as they hosted a thank you Dinner for him at the Railway. Following his retirement from Pentan and the move to town he was persuaded to stand for Carmarthen Town Council. That led eventually to his election as Mayor in 2016 prompting the quip that he'd moved from The Pentan (fireside) to the Parlour. At that Mayor's Parlour, like his predecessors, Wyn hosted many visitors, both local and foreign.

So under the direction of experienced Mayor's Secretary Eleri Jones, began a hectic year of Diary controlled events and meetings. Visits to Schools, Homes, Hospital (on Christmas morning) mixed with meetings, Dinners and Receptions. Then Mayoral celebrations at Haverfordwest, Kidwelly, Llanelli and an early alarm clock call to get to the Portreeve's Breakfast in Laugharne. Being already a well known public figure he hardly needed an introduction wherever he went. "*What impressed me most was the welcome I got everywhere particularly from school children*". He was proud to see the Mayor's Charity Fund top £4,000, distributed amongst 15 local organisations, glad to witness 770 runners for the Mayor's Race, and the growth in the Saint David's Day town celebrations. Amongst all that and more, what impressed him most? "*It was seeing the brave efforts of those disadvantaged pupils at Myrddin and QE High Schools in spite of all.....It brought tears to my eyes. We don't realise how lucky we are sometimes*".

Here was a popular and public Mayor, deserving the welcome he got everywhere and whenever he spoke his bilingual approach was much appreciated. How nice to hear the Annual Goodwill Message under the Town Hall this year so lucidly delivered in both Welsh and English. Looking back, "*A lot busier than I'd imagined, but an unique experience I wouldn't have missed for the world!*". Well done Wyn, and well done the National Eisteddfod for admitting him into the Orsedd in Anglesey this year.
