Telephone Scams.

It has come to my notice, that a few residents of the Village have been getting Scam telephone calls.

This is an old one but as it has reared its ugly head again, I thought I would remind you of how it works. It takes various forms and comes from various telephone numbers but generally speaking, it's the same Scam.

Someone calls and says they are from BT, Microsoft or some other organisation. Sometimes the calls are from abroad but could also be from the UK. I have had 02 (London) numbers on our Landline and my Mobile. They will say - "Your IP address has been compromised" and suggest you **MUST** switch on your PC immediately to resolve it. **DO NOT DO THIS.**

Others may say that you have serious errors on your PC. - same message - **DO NOT DO ANYTHING.**

You have **NOT** been compromised and you do **NOT** have errors.

One potential victim was told that the caller was from BT and that their PC had been compromised, they asked the caller for his name - probably Noddy or Big ears, but usually a normal name spoken with a foreign accent! When he was asked to prove he was from BT - he couldn't - the potential victim put the phone down and blocked the callers number - Safe and sensible idea.

Some scammers play a recorded message when you first answer which offers you some options, 1 - speak to the caller (you don't have to as it's a Scam - proven by the initial scary message) or 2 - be transferred to their representative. In some cases, if you do this, you could be charged for a Premium rate call, even though you did not make the call. I have checked this out with BT and it is still a possibility.

This reminds me about an article I wrote a while ago when they tried to fool you into downloading some software which let them on to your PC to "control" it and "fix" the problems. It led to you being locked out and forced to pay a ransom - sorry, pay for software - to get back in.

Be warned, be careful, be vigilant. Please look after any residents who may be subject to such a nasty scam.

Brechfa Forest West Wind Farm Community Fund

The fund is now open for applications.

How are the funds allocated?

All decisions on the allocation of funds are made by a panel of local volunteers from the 6km area of benefit, with a variety of interests and backgrounds, across the age spectrum, to ensure every demographic group is fairly represented.

The panel feel it is wise to reflect the practice of other similar funds and will remain anonymous. Panel members could be subject to harassment or comment via social media etc. if their identities became public knowledge. This decision has been agreed, not only to protect the wellbeing and integrity of their work but also to ensure they are not lobbied or pressurised individually by organisations wishing to make applications for funding.

Who is eligible to apply?

- Voluntary or community organisations
- Constituted community groups, registered charities
- A not for profit company or Community Interest Company
- Social Enterprises
- PTA's on behalf of schools
- Statutory bodies will be eligible if they can demonstrate the project has strong partnership links with the local community and that they are the best placed organisation to undertake the project.

Your application will need to demonstrate how your project significantly benefits communities within the area of benefit for the fund (this area is initially 6km from the wind turbines and includes Llanpumsaint)

Exclusions

Initially, the scheme will not be open to individuals and businesses. However, the eligibility criteria will be reviewed after the initial round of funding. Therefore we are very keen to hear from individuals and businesses that would like to apply to the fund so we can develop a picture of the local funding needs beyond community groups.

Llanpumsaint Community Council

By now, the Community Council is operating according to the new resolution which means that Council Meetings occur on alternate months and the most recent meeting was held in July. It was very pleasing to be able to report that the collapsed bridge had been repaired and that it was by now, business as usual for everybody. Probably, there was no one more glad of the restoration than the faithful postman, as the detour added a considerable amount of time to his daily route.

An unexpected offer came from the County Council during the month of May which was, to replace all of the Phillips Low Pressure Sodium streetlamps with Light Emitting Diode (LED) bulbs. According to County Council records, there are 33 lanterns to update and each replacement or substitution will cost £139. The County will loan the capital amount to the Community Council, who will make annual repayments over the next 8 years. It is claimed that the saving in electricity use will more than cover the cost of the loan repayment. This programme of replacement is being offered to every Town and Community Council throughout the County for two reasons, one being the significant reduction in the use of electricity and the other, that Phillips are no longer producing the Low Pressure Sodium Lamps!

Llanpumsaint – a walk down memory lane

Last year I was given Arwyn Thomas's 'History of Llanpumsaint'. It brought back many happy memories of boyhood visits from war-time Cardiff to Llanpumsaint and I decided to pay the village another visit. Arwyn kindly acted as my escort.

I grew up in Rumney, Cardiff. My Dad and David Evans (Uncle Dai) of Pantycelyn were first cousins and between 1943 and 1948 I spent most summers with Uncle Dai and Aunt May at Pantycelyn. My most lasting memory is of food. We weren't starving in Cardiff but the food was monotonous. It was so very different at Pantycelyn. Uncle Dai was a butcher and there was always meat of various kinds on the table. My Auntie May made bread, butter and cheese, which were delicious. The Evans's kept open house – anyone in the vicinity was welcome to drop by and have a meal and many did. I can remember on one occasion we had 12 sitting down for Sunday roast.

But there was no sentimentality – it was a working farm. There were numerous cats and the females were always having kittens. I once watched my Auntie May drown 8 unwanted kittens in the water trough, one after the other. On another occasion she chopped off the head of a chicken, which got away and ran three times round the farmyard, headless, before keeling over!

Saturday was Carmarthen Mart, where Uncle Dai had a meat stall. For me it was a fascinating place. In the centre you had a large hall where the auctioneer would sell cows, sheep, pigs and horses. There was then a gap between the Hall and at least 32 butchers' stalls around the Hall. It seemed every village around Carmarthen had a butcher and each had his own stall with his name and village painted above. I thought it impossible for so many butchers to be able to make a living but it was apparent that each had his own faithful following. Electricity at Pantycelyn came from a generator and there were two batteries for the radio. It was my job once a week to take the batteries down to the woollen mill – leave them to be re-charged and come back to Pantycelyn with two re-charged ones. Boy, were they heavy. I suppose nowadays you wouldn't let a young boy stagger half a mile round a village with 2 heavy acid batteries, but no-one was the slightest bit concerned then. Water at Pantycelyn came from a well in the inner courtyard and it was my daily job to pump for half an hour and fill up the cisterns. On my recent visit, the Bearmans, who now own the house and are in the middle of extensive refurbishment, kindly showed me around and I was able to point out where the well was sited. There is no sign of it now but it will be there, capped and buried below the surface.

There were about a dozen evacuees in Llanpumsaint when I first came to stay. Llanpumsaint was very much a Welsh-speaking village and in no time at all the evacuees had learnt Welsh. But boy, did they give me a hard time. 'You come from the capital of Wales and you can't speak Welsh. Call yourself Welsh!' The local children, however, were very friendly. My particular friend was Trevor Thomas, and thanks to Arwyn I have re-established contact with Trevor after 70 years. He now lives in Carmarthen. Meinhir Lewis, the Vicar's daughter was another I remember. She was a red-head and a bit of a tomboy. She married and moved to Aberystwyth but sadly died a few years ago.

I also remember once travelling with my parents from Carmarthen all the way to Aberystwyth. That was a journey and a half. I think there were 22 stations in all, magical places such as Strata Florida and the wilderness at Tregaron, with the dizzying descent to Aberystwyth. Maybe one day the line will be re-opened – what a tourist attraction that would be!

Beauty or the Beast?

Travelling recently to Llandysul I stopped to admire the fabulous seasonal display along our very own Laburnum Road. This year's display has been wondrous but I was also reminded about the beast behind all that beauty. Laburnum anagyroides, common laburnum or the golden chain or golden rain – ironically so apt given our June downpours – is a common site in our parks, gardens and playing fields because of the beauty of the flowering bush. It has been deliberately cultivated in southern European gardens since the late middle ages, and around 1560 was introduced north of the Alps, into England and even the United States?

But did you know: All parts of the tree are poisonous: roots, bark, wood, leaves, flower-buds, petals, and seedpods. The harmful part of the plant is the seedpods which are mistaken by children for peapods, usually after they have been shown how to eat fresh raw peas straight from the plant in the vegetable garden. A fatal dose for children is three to four pods or twelve to fifteen seeds of laburnum.

In many cases of ingestion of a small number of seeds there are no symptoms. Where symptoms do occur these are usually nausea and vomiting. Higher doses can produce intense sleepiness, convulsive possibly tetanic movements, coma, slight frothing at the mouth and unequally dilated pupils. The active ingredient, cytisine, has effects often described as being very similar to nicotine. It seems, however, that it is not nearly as strong a poison as nicotine. Interestingly, during World War I, experiments were conducted aimed at using laburnum to replace tobacco. In earlier times, the seeds and leaves were used as a psycho-pharmaceutical agent to treat excessive irritability, psychoneurotic illnesses, migraines, chronic arsenic poisoning and liver ailments?

So my advice would be, definitely admire but keep well away!

Herio hen problem

Wrth i'r gwaith anferth o drwsio'r hewl ger Ffarm Y Pante yn Bronwydd nesau at ei deryn, daw rhyddhad i'r swyddogion, y gweithwyr a phawb sy'n defnyddio'r A484. Petai e' yma o hyd byddai'r holl brysurddeb wedi codi gwen ar wyneb yr hen Gtismond Phillips (1792 – 1850), o bias Cwmgwili'r ochor arall i'r cwm a'r afon Gwili. Fel aelod o Fwrdd Prifffyrdd Y Sir, nol yn 1848 tynnodd sylw'r Pwyllgor at gyflwr peryglus y darn yma o'r hewl o Gaertfyrddin i Cynwil, rhwng Henallt a'r Bronwydd. Dywedodd fod yna gwymp o hanner can troedfedd i'r dibyn heb unrhyw beth i arbed teithwyr. Yr eglurhad gafodd oedd bod yr Arolygwr i drefnu llanw'r gegendor gyda cherig oedd yn weddill o'r hewl. Ymatebodd yr hen uchelwr y gallent lanw cerrig am yr hanner can mlynedd nesa' heb wneud unrhyw argraff yr y sefyllfa. Ychwanegodd mai'r unig ateb fyddai wal gadarn a chynnigodd y cerrig iddynt o'i gwar personol. Penderfynodd y Pwyllgor wneud dim ac anwybyddu'r sefyllfa.

Rhyw ddeng mlynedd wedyn gwelwyd gweithwyr di-ri yn torri trac i'r rheilffordd newydd o Gaertfyrddin tua Abertystwyth ar hyd y Gwili, islaw'r darn yma o hewl. Gyda chymaint o gerrig yn cael eu taffu i bobman pam na atgyweithiwyd y pishyn yma? Well Pwy fase'n gwastrefu arian i riparo hen feic yng nghefn y sied pan fod car newydd sbon ar gyrraedd Cyn gynted ag agorwyd y rhaflfordd yn 1860 bellach aeth yr holl nwyddau ar y tren. Calch, glo a phopeth arall i'r ffermydd a'r ffatrioedd gwlan yn teithio lan y lein, a'u holl gynnyrch a choed o'r gelltydd yn mynd 'nol lawr. Felly aeth yr hewl nawr yn ddibwys, cerddwyr ac ambell gart a cheffyl a welwyd arni bellach.. Felna y bu am y ganrif nes ar deryn yr Ail Ryfel Byd gwelwyd mwy a mwy o gerbydau yn defnyddio'r hewl. Pan syrthiodd bwyell Beeching i roi tertyn ar y rheilffordd yma yn 1962 gwelwyd yr holl drafnidiaeth yn dychweliad i'r hewlydd. Ddegawd ar ôl degawd daeth mwy a mwy o lorïau, yn amlach ac yn drymach, bob blwyddyn Yna yn y diwedd ildiodd yr hewl fach fregus, i gadarnhau holl bryderon yr hen Gtismond.

Solution for an old problem.

Seeing the massive remedial work on the A484 road below Bronwydd nearing its conclusion will no doubt please planners, contractors and long delayed road users alike. Had he still been around no doubt Grismond Philipps (1792 - 1850), of Cwmgwili Mansion, just across the valley from the roadworks would have smiled wily. Way back in November 1848, as a member of the County Road Board, he drew attention to the dangerous state of this section of road. *from a place called Henallt to the Bronwydd Arms.... there being a precipice some fifty feet in depth adjoining the road with no protection.* He was informed that the surveyor had been told many times to deposit scrapings at the side to create an embankment. Grismond retorted that if scrapings were deposited for the next fifty years they would not solve the problem. Only a stone wall would create an efficient barrier and offered stone from his quarry should they proceed. No decision was made, so the problem remained.

Some ten years later vast gangs of navvies arrived carving a route along the Gwili, below this problem road, for the new Carmarthen to Aberystwyth railway. So with so much stone flying around why wasn't some filling done then? Simply because trains now took over, as all heavy traffic switched to the tracks, as lime, coal farm and factory needs came up line, so wood, agricultural and woollen produce steamed out. Only pedestrians and light horse and carts continued to use this Carmarthen road northwards through Bronwydd to Conwil. In short who would spend money nowadays on repairing that rusty mudguard on the old bicycle at the back of the shed as you excitedly await delivery of a brand new car?

The train reigned supreme for a hundred years. Then road vehicles become increasingly popular in the 1930's and more so after 1945. Dr Beeching closing this railway line in 1962 confirmed an escalating trend as more and more heavy traffic shifted back on the roads. More lorries, heavier and more frequent, into the 21st century punished this long recognised fragile section of highway. Finally it gave way in 2018, to fulfill Grismond's long lost fears.
