## **West Wales Rivers Trust – ‘Adopt a Tributary’ project We Need Your help!**

With funding from NRW and DwrCymru/Welsh Water, the West Wales Rivers Trust begun work in July 2019 on a catchment scale project within the Tywi to improve the access for migratory fish to important spawning tributaries in this once great fishing river.

This project is a response to the worrying decline in numbers of Atlantic Salmon and Sewin (Sea Trout) that have been recorded over many decades. While there are efforts to mitigate pressures out at sea, in the estuaries of Welsh rivers, and improve water quality in general, the IUCN and fisheries bodies cite habitat improvement works are very important to increase the Fry to Smolt (young to sub adult) stages of the fish life cycle. This in turn boosts the number of returning fish in the following years.

The work being promoted by the Trust is ideally suited to Citizen Science projects based in the communities found in the headwaters of the spawning streams. Over this winter we hope to be undertaking some tree planting in the area around Llanpumsaint as well as mapping invasive species and barriers, so there is something for everyone to get involved with!

## Scam News!

Following on from my last article in October 2019:

If you do any transactions online, you may have heard of the new 2 step verification process that many organisations - such as banks - are advising you to use. This typically uses your password plus a code sent to your device (text message etc) if you have one, or an automated phone call to let you know what the one-off code is. The code could be a sequence of numbers.

A few weeks ago, Vi needed to request a phone call from an organisation as part of the new online security 2 step verification process.

As we have a Call Blocker phone, I had to turn the blocking facility off otherwise the automated call would not get through. More about this later.

Within minutes we received a scam call, so our Call Blocking phone works very well - when switched on. I am in no way affiliated with BT but I can say that the BT Premium Call Blocker phone we have had for some time now does what it says on the tin. If someone calls you who is not in your phone book, then they are rejected and directed to say who they are, then press the # key.

If it is an automated call, whether from a valid source (bank) - as above with a valid code - or from a machine automating calls, then it cannot press the # key so it is simply blocked without disturbing you. If the caller complies and states their name and presses the # key, then they are put through as an "Announced call", the phone rings and you then have options to reject, send to answer-phone or block etc.

**Recalling a phone-book number can be a little cumbersome at first but only takes a few seconds. But, we can forgive this as the Call Blocker system is excellent and since we purchased them, we have not had any unwanted calls, the odd one who complies is simply blocked and never gets through again.**

**Stop Press:** Since writing this article, we noticed that there was a program on Channel 5 on Tuesday the 26<sup>th</sup> November (1 hour), called How to stop your nuisance calls. Some of the tricks and gadgetry the scammers, fraudsters, cold callers, have at their disposal is incredible, e.g. *robocalls computer*. Gadgets and telephone lists bought for pennies! If you have access to the Internet, it's worth while watching on catch up. In your favourite browser, just search for *cb5 catch up*, then click on <https://www.channel5.com> and it will take you to a Channel 5 search, type in - *how to stop your nuisance* - and the program will be found. Enjoy.

## Pension Credit - Make sure you receive what you're entitled to

As the Older People's Commissioner for Wales, I have seen the positive difference that Pension Credit can make to older people's lives but every year thousands of older people in Wales miss out on millions of pounds of unclaimed financial entitlements. If your weekly pension is less than £167.25 (£255.25 for couples), you may be eligible for Pension Credit, which tops up your income and unlocks a range of other entitlements, such as council tax discounts, free dental treatment and help with housing costs. You may still be entitled to Pension Credit even if you own your own home or have savings and other income.

Call the Pension Credit claim line now to make sure you receive what you're entitled to! Phone 0800 99 1234. The average amount of Pension Credit received by those claiming is £58 a week, which could boost your income by as much as £3,000 a year!

It's really easy to claim Pension Credit - all it takes is a phone call. You just need your national insurance number, your bank details and information about your income and savings.

## The year 1919

After four years of war, worry and sad funerals, peace reigned at last. With profound relief the local community welcomed home no less than thirteen returning soldiers. First back was David Jones of Penllwynuchel Nebo, whose Welcome Home concert on the 10<sup>th</sup> of January, collected the princely sum of £14 15s – 3d. He was closely followed by released long term prisnor-of-war Gwyn Morris from Germany, whose younger brother Emrys had been killed in France. Met by excited friends at the station he was escorted in a carriage down to the village to the repeated strains of “*For he's a jolly good fellow!*”. In February John Davies Tirbach arrived, closely followed by Johnny Lewis Station House and Tom Edwards Penybont (brother to William Edwards of Garage and sports shop fame in Carmarthen). By the end of the month singers and performers repeated their routines at the school to welcome back Lewis Jones Cerrigbychain, who got £9-2s-6d, B Jones Glanyrafon and Tom Lewis home from the Navy. Then in March another concert honoured yet another four, one of them Thomas Bowen destined to become our eccentric country postman operating from his derelict Cwmeinon home. Willie Thomas Gladstone Hall, W Bishop of Llethr and D Rees 5 Gwili Terrace were the other grateful three. On the 23<sup>rd</sup> of May yet another concert and collection for Tom Thomas, home to the Railwat Hotel to deliver coal from the Station yard with his faithful horse Polly. The celebrations culminated on the 25<sup>th</sup> of July with a huge parish gathering for a Peace Celebration. Following a School Tea there was a village procession to a sports and prizes event on Y Felin field, and a second tea before a grand open-air concert finalised by Llanpumsaint choir under Ben Daniels. Sunday evening saw a United Prayer Meeting at Bethel Chapel, attended by all demoninations to thank God for peace. Within a month that choir really put Llanpumsaint on the map. Competing in the cheif choral contest at Carmarthen’s National Eisteddfod, held in the park in front of packed thousands, they came first out of seven Wales wide choirs, to win £20 and great honour. Ben Daniels Gerwyn Villa was delighted. The shining generosity of our local community in a frugal immediate post-war situation was extraordinary. Over that short six months in early 1919 the collected contributons for those 13 returning soldiers averaged out at £9 to £10 each, as well as the £55 donated on the July celebration day. Though many of us got to know those returning soldiers in the decades that followed, they did not share their experiencies. The whole War became a closed book, locked away as society chose to forget the whole enormity of that travesty.

Early in 1919 the authorities had to re-advertise the post of Medical Officer for Conwil and Llanpumsaint because Dr Yourath had moved on to Pontyberem. Maybe the state of the road to Conwil put applicants off, since Dr Yourath had complained it had ruined 3 motor-cycles for him. Using it could prove hazardous.

Hymn writer Elfed’s two daughters, back visiting Blaenycoed from London, lost all their eggs when their trap overturned. They were unhurt, a fate more fortunate than that for the blacksmith of Abernant, killed when his horse bolted to overturn the gambo. Then Bronwen Thomas arrived very late for her wedding ceremony in Carmarthen, after her motor car escort became involved in a fracas with a horse and cart near Helfa Hall. 76 year Anne Mathias from Llandysul, dropped dead near Llanpumsaint station after visiting her parents in Llanllawddog, who were, aged believe it or not, 88 and 93. You can hardly blame the condition of the road for that one!

1919 also saw a number of farms being put up for sale. In June the sale of the Ffosmaen estate went for £2,800, which included Llwyniar, Gwarcwm and Manbras (now Panteg). A bid of £700 for the 18 acre Pantyfedwen was refused and it was readavertised. Pengraigyrystum in Nebo and Pistyllgwyn in Bronwydd also came on the market. Then Autumn saw the usual well attended stock and crop sales as farms changed hands, so in addition to the above people hurried in search of a bargain to Glancorwg in Llanpumsaint and then down to Cwmdwyfran farm, above hat village. The other positive came as Carmarthen District Council agreed to construct a bridge at Glanyryns, which reappeared in the news recently. By the way, if someone has picked up an ancient looking set of dentures along the road towards Bronwydd, please ring the Journal, for on the 19<sup>th</sup> of September 1919 it reported that the finder would be rewarded
