


## Publication of Arwyn Thomas' Autobiography “Mwy Nag Un Llwyfan” (More than one stage)

## **A Whoosh of Starlings and a Clattering of Jackdaws**

We are entertained every evening by starlings and jackdaws, in very different ways.

The starlings fly over from 4.00pm in large groups, all going west north west, over the hill by Nantygelli. Each group flies over with a large whoosh, but no calling. We get about 6 groups flying over, followed by some who are late on parade. They all seem to come from the east, on the same trajectory. Does anyone know if there is a murmuration in Carmarthenshire?

Then every evening at this time of year, just on dusk, we get a large number of jackdaws congregating from all round the area over our part of the village. We hear them before we see them, small flocks coming from all points of the compass. It takes up to 15 - 20 minutes for all the groups to arrive and coalesce and then the show begins. They swoop and twist, calling to each other, just like a murmuration of starlings but with the clattering sound that jackdaws are famous for. A few crows try to join in, but they are not so acrobatic so give up and fly away. Then all of a sudden, as darkness falls, the whole flock flies over the wood, goes quiet and they drop down to roost for the night.

## **Ever wondered what happens to our waste water?**

With recent attention on the quality of our waterways, a representative from Dwr Cymru held an informal meeting with the Village Voice editorial team.

Dwr Cymru is one of 11 water and sewerage companies in England and Wales, and is the only one that is not-for-profit. The company provides water and wastewater services to over 3 million people, covering most of Wales, Herefordshire and parts of Deeside. The company supports over 130,000 more vulnerable customers with assistance to pay their bills and encourages anyone to get in touch if they are struggling with their water bills.

The company also operates a Priority Services Register where customers (parents with a baby, someone who has an illness that requires water, or has sight or hearing difficulties or are elderly or disabled) can register and ensure that they receive bottled water should there be any interruptions to their water supply. Llanpumsaint has one of the 800 small treatment works in Wales. As in many parts of the country, we have a combined sewage and surface runoff system. About 8 years ago, £6 million was spent on upgrading the sewage system in the village. Despite this investment, the system is unable to cope with extreme rainfall events which result in excessive runoff. On these occasions, the treatment works is permitted to divert water from the treatment system straight into the river. In 2020, there were just over 150 such spills and this amount was within the permit limit. In 2022, Dwr Cymru will be conducting invertebrate studies to look at the impact of the spills on local water quality. One of the major challenges the company faces are blockages, caused by people flushing everyday items like cotton buds and wet wipes down the toilet; or rinsing things like fat, oil and food scrapings down the sink. With approximately 2,000 blockages reported every month, £7 million is invested each year to tackle blockages in the sewer network. ## **DOTs Youth Group**

On Saturday, the 23rd of October, we went to Skanda Vale as part of our Peace Mala Accreditation journey. We all arrived at 11 o' clock in the morning and stayed until 3pm. We were welcomed by Brother Francis and we learnt some of the history of Skanda Vale. It was bought in 1973 by Guru Sri Subramanium of Sri Lanka as a 22 acre farm . Today Skanda Vale is over 300 acres, as well as having the Skanda Vale hospice at Saron. Over the years the farm has been home to deer, buffalo, peacocks, parrots and many more. In 1982, Skanda Vale welcomed a young elephant named Valli all the way from Sri Lanka. Valli is now over forty years old. Three years ago, another elephant was re-homed there. She is another female elephant named Lakshmi.

After an interesting talk by Brother Francis, we walked up through the winding woodland road. First we visited the Guru's grave and memorial statue. It was the Guru's wish was to be buried on that site. After paying our respects , we made our way towards the Maha Shakti temple , formerly a separate smallholding named Pengarn. We passed a few beautiful brown deer in the small paddock and there were a few chickens roaming around. We passed the old enclosure where Valli used to live, having a few years ago outgrown it and moved to larger accommodation. We waited for the elephants to return from their walk and then were allowed in to the enclosure to see them and feed them. We fed them some chopped bananas, apples and melons. Hand feeding an elephant was a new experience for many of us.

Following this experience, we re- traced our steps back down to the Subramanium temple. We were very privileged to be able to sit inside the temple for the "pooja" as many people had to sit outside in marquees and watch virtually. It was a very spiritual experience for us all, but also very educational to learn about their way of living. We were then invited for a meal of curry and rice, followed by a lovely cup of tea. After a visit to the shop we said good-bye . We all enjoyed our visit to Skanda Vale and would like to thank everyone there for their warm welcome. Emma
