Iestyn Jones, aged 16 of Nant yr Ynys Llanpumsaint, has been competing all season in his home-built Nissan Micra in the South Wales league and the British Autograss series. The British Autograss series is held over 5 rounds across Britain, where a points cumulated over the 5 rounds, comprising 3 heats and a final per round.

It was all to play for in the final round. Iestyn went into the round in 5th position but the top 8 competitors were all very close. Iestyn knew he had a chance of the title if he have a good weekend. And that he certainly did! Iestyn won all his heats and the final meaning he gained the top points and the top honour of Junior Saloon British Autograss champion.



Dafydd Jones, Iestyn's father who has built and maintained the car all season, said "This year has been phenomenal! It's Iestyn's last year in juniors so we really have focused our efforts on him to give him the chance to do the best he

could in his final year. He certainly paid back the faith we have shown in him as Iestyn's CV from this year consists: Teifi Autograss club Junior Champion, South Wales League Junior Champion, Junior National runner up (2nd) in final and Junior Saloon British Champion.

I thank our sponsors whom without their help, these achievements wouldn't be possible, I have to thank my fiancée Del who has supported us in so many ways, and the family and friends for always either being available to help or give us moral support."

Fresh spate of scams – be alert – information from OFGEM

Never one to miss an opportunity, the scammers are out in force, viewing the Government's assistance for energy bills as a golden opportunity to catch us all out. If you receive a text or email purporting to be from OFGEM asking you to click a link to claim your energy assistance be very careful, as it is likely to be a scam (savings should be applied direct by your energy supplier). **Do NOT click on the link.**

If you aren't sure about any email, clicking "Reply" should disclose the email address of the sender (but do not press Send!). If it just says (for example) OFGEM (with no proper address), or has a suspect looking email address, then it is likely to be a scam. If you do receive one, please report it – the Government can't know the scale of the problem if everyone just deletes them. Texts can be forwarded (free for most mobile providers) to 7726. Scam emails should be forwarded to report@phishing.gov.uk.

West Wales Dowsers

Dowsing is a useful and interesting practice almost anyone can learn. It's thought to have originated in Egypt or even earlier. There are 4 defibrillators in the Llanpumsaint Area, please check the location nearest to you.

- Outside Village Hall SA33 6BZ
- Outside Railway Inn SA33 6BU
- On wall outside Henfryn, Ffynnon Henry SA33 6LD
- Outside the Vestry Nebo SA33 6HN

All the defibrillators are listed on The Circuit, a UK register which the Ambulance Service access if they get a call re an unresponsive casualty. So please check out the location nearest to you, and if ever you need to access a defibrillator you know where the nearest one is located. You do not need a code to access the defib, and the ambulance service will be there to advise while you are on the phone with location and use.

No formal "training" is required to use an AED, the 999 Dispatcher talks you through as does the Unit itself. Please visit [Lifesaver \(life-saver.org.uk\)](http://lifesaver.life-saver.org.uk) interactive scenarios any time – viewing these will give you confidence, and they are free and very informative.

September's Forest Church



Welcome to the Chapel
Croeso i Gapel Ffynnonhenri
(Gaynor Jones-Higgs)

The September Forest Church took us on a walk from the Church to Ffynnonhenri Chapel, following some of the old footpaths. We were shown around the Chapel which had been built in a remote spot in 1735 at a time when Baptists were persecuted and jailed for their beliefs. We drank fresh water from the spring and saw the steps which descended into the stream for baptisms.

Before the original Chapel was built people worshipped in houses and farmhouses. In this area they were Ffynnon where the Chapel is now), Broneithin (now named Quarre), Nantgwyn, Glandwr and Glanych (now demolished near Fronheulog). People walked from afar or came on horseback.

There wasn't enough room in the Chapel so only the elderly, mothers and children were allowed to sit down and the rest had to stand. Worshippers from this area walked all the way to Rhydwllym in Pembrokeshire for communion as the Chapel at the time was not registered.

The vestry was originally a school room with a stable below where worshippers kept their horses during the service. In 1820 there were 400 members; in 1869, 360 members; and today, 35 members. The Chapel was once very influential in the area and was responsible for the foundation of half a dozen chapels in west Wales, including Caersalem in the village.

Eglwys Y Goedwig – Mis Medi

Cyn adeiladu'r Capel addolai'r bobl mewn tai a ffermydd. Yn lleol, yma Ffynnon (sef lleoliad y capel heddiw), Broneithin (Cwarre erbyn hyn), Nantgwyn, Glandwr a Lanychen (adfail nawr ger Fronheulog). Byddent yn cerdded o bell neu ar gefn ceffylau. Gan mae cyfyng oedd hi yn y capel rhaid oedd aros ar draed os nad oeddech yn fam neu blentyn. Cyn i Ffynnonhenri gael ei gofrestri rhaid oedd cerdded bob cam i Rydwilym yn Sir Benfro am y Cymun

Ystafell ysgol fu'r festri'n wreiddiol gyda stabl i'r ceffylau islaw adeg y gwasanaeth. Yn 1820 'roedd yna 400 aelod, gyda 360 yn 1869, ond erbyn heddiw 35 yn unig sydd. Un adeg bu Ffynnonhenri'n ddylanwadol iawn yn yr ardal, yn gyfrifol am sefydlu rhyw hanner dwsin i gapeli eraill gan gynnwys Caersalem yn Llanpumsaint.
