Gwili Railway – 150 years old in 2010

2010 is rather a special one for us at The Gwili Railway, for it was in 1860, 150 years ago, that the railway from Carmarthen reached Conwil. It was another 4 years before it reached Llanpumsaint in 1864. We will be celebrating the 150th anniversary of the grand opening on Saturday 4th September 2010 at Bronwydd Arms, and the Board of Directors have also decided to introduce a Gwili Railway Local Residents Discount card.

The card is available to residents of Abergwili, Bronwydd, Cynwly Elfed, Llanpumsaint and Carmarthen Town. The card, which is valid until the end of the year, costs £1 and gives a 25% discount for the card holder and one other person on the normal timetabled trains. It is not valid for special events such as Day Out with Thomas, Santa Special or dining trains. In order to obtain a card, all that you need to do is to call in the office at Bronwydd with proof of residence and £1 coin and the card will be issued there and then!

The Gwili Railway has always enjoyed support from local communities such as with school visits, meals on the train and of course the popular Thomas events and Steaming into Christmas, so it seemed appropriate to reward the local community with a discount card.

There are many many changes in the area since the railway reached Llanpumsaint and often people forget that the coming of the railway not only changed this area, but it changed the whole world. One of the supporters of the railway system being introduced was the Victorian writer R. S. Surtees, the creator of the sporting grocer, John Jorrocks. He was very enthusiastic about being able to travel distances. He once said that "...you do not have to marry your neighbour's daughter now that you can travel by train....". Well at the Gwili Railway we cannot guarantee that you will find a wife or husband on the Gwili Railway, but do try our loyalty card! *Jeremy John - Business Administrator for the Gwili Railway*

Rheilffordd Gwili - 150 blwydd oed yn 2010

Mae 2010 yn flwyddyn gyffrous i ni yn Rheilffordd Gwili oherwydd yn 1860, 150 o flynyddoedd yn ol fe wnaeth y rheilffordd o Gaerfyrddin gyrraedd Cynwyl Elfed. Pedair blynedd yn ddiweddarach y cyrhaeddodd y rheilffordd Llanpumsaint sef yn 1864. Fe fyddwn yn dathlu'r achlysur yma sef penblwydd yr agoriad ar ddydd Sadwrn Medi 4 2010 ym Mronwydd ac mae'r Bwrdd Rheoli wedi penderfynnu cyflwyno cerdyn sef Cerdyn Gostyngiad Rheilffordd Gwili ar gyfer trigolion lleol.

Fe fydd y cerdyn ar gael i drigolion Abergwili, Bronwydd, Cynwyl Elfed, Llanpumsaint a Thref Caerfyrddin. Mae'r cerdyn a fydd yn ddilys tan ddiwedd y flwyddyn yn costio £1 ac yn rhoi disgownt o 25% i berchen y cerdyn ac un person arall ar drennau a fydd yn ymddangos ar yr amserlen. Nid yw y cerdyn yn ddilys ar gyfer digwyddiadau pwysig sef Diwrnod allan gyda Tomos, Tren Sion Corn a thrennau bwyd.. I gael cerdyn galwch yn y swyddfa ym Mronwydd gyda phrawf eich bod yn byw yn y dalgylch ac hefyd £1 ac fe gewch y cerdyn yn ddiymdroi.

Mae Rheilffordd Gwili wedi cael cefnogaeth bob amser gan gymunedau lleol fel ymweliad ysgolion, bwyd ar y tren a hefyd a phob digwyddiad achlysurol arall felly mae yn bwrpasol iawn fod y cymunedau lleol yn derbyn y cerdyn hyn.

Roedd e yn frwd iawn am ei fod yn medru teithio ymhell iawn ac fe ddywedodd unwaith "Nid oes yn awr rhaid i chi briodi merch eich cymydog oherwydd medrwch yn awr deithio ymhell gyda thren." Nid ydym ni yma yn Rheilffordd Gwili yn gallu sicrhau y medrwn gael gafael mewn gwr neu wraig i chi ond da chi, cymerwch fantes o'n Cerdyn Gostyngiad. Jeremy John Rheolwr Busnes Rheilffordd Gwili.



The trophies were presented by Steve Evans. The player of the year trophy went by a clear margin to Richard Arran and was presented to him by Mike of the Railway Inn.


