Matters Arising	<p>Highways: No news regarding the Traffic Calming Plan. Councillors unanimously agree that Clerk write to County Council Chief Executive, referring to County’s reluctance to action Community’s requests; local residents lose faith in Community Council</p> <p>Public Footpath at Nantgwyn: Council agree with proposed re-routing of path away from farmyard</p> <p>Public Conveniences: Clerk quoted from correspondence received from Welsh Govt regarding the review of provision of public toilets.</p> <p>Wilderness near Penbontbren: Clerk to continue making investigations regarding ownership of land.</p> <p>Memorial Plaque: AN informed Council that cost of purchasing/erecting stone would be £590 + VAT</p> <p>Vicarage: CS shared with Council more information on the planning consent conditions; the road hedge to be recessed back 2 metres.</p>	
Correspondence	<p>One Voice Wales: information regarding Annual Conference.</p> <p>Broadband: CS received information that upgrading requires changing the green box situated near the Church. BT state that work should be completed by end of November.</p> <p>Playing Field: Clerk to forward relevant e-mail to PJ.</p> <p>Alan Richards letter: a keen walker and local historian who complained about the state of public footpaths around Ffynnonhenri Chapel. Councillors discussed reply letter, CS unwilling with letter content but reply letter to be sent</p>	
Planning	<p>Rhyd y Gaer: request to use the property as two dwellings. ED confirmed that it had been renovated as a two dwelling property many years ago.</p> <p>Penllainddu: no discussion, as property outside of Community boundary.</p>	

Financial Matters	<p>Trywydd: £51.60p: Agreed to pay, AN & PJ</p> <p>BDO audit: require that risk assessment be discussed within appropriate financial year. Agreed to discuss matter in February meeting</p>
