Matters Arising	<p><b>Wales Audit Office</b> – Clerk summarised the contents of a letter received from Deryck Evans of the WAO.</p> <p><b>IRPW</b> – Clerk had received a reply which stated that it was Carmarthenshire County Council that set the wages of the Chief Executive.</p> <p><b>Traffic Improvement Plan</b> – Clerk has received a reply from J McEvoy; a meeting date to be set to discuss the final phase.</p> <p><b>Darren King/Tony Williams</b> – Clerk has received response from them, referring to the maintenance work that needs doing on the roads in the community; Bancyffordd road is due to be resurfaced when funds are available and the Bancyn/Bwthyn section will be repaired when necessary. <b>DD</b> commented on the effects of budget cutbacks.</p>	
Correspondence	<p><b>One Voice Wales</b> – A new officer has been appointed to represent South Wales; Mel ab Owain. Clerk suggested that he could be invited to attend a Council meeting and the Councillors agreed.</p> <p><b>Public Footpaths</b> – Clerk had received communication from the County, requesting help with their maintenance. The Councillors were of the opinion that there could be unforeseen implications of doing so with an increase of ongoing responsibilities. <b>IJ</b> suggested that additional costs could be met from the Precept.</p> <p><b>GDPR</b> – One Voice Wales had been discussing the new regulations with Welsh Government and had reached an agreement that Community Councils would not need to appoint a designated Data Control Officer.</p> <p>Emlyn Dole – Chair of County Council stated that Chief Executive had received a pay rise along with all Council employees.</p> <p><b>Insurance</b> – The agreement with Zurich has now ended; Clerk to seek out quotes.</p>
