07/22/30	AOB	In response to matters raised by individual Councillors, the Council discussed and Agreed: (i) The Clerk be instructed to request a site meeting with Highways officers to discuss the need for safety barriers on the road nr Bronallt, and to seek support on this issue from County Councillor Bryan Davies. (ii) A fee estimate should be sought from a property lawyer to get the title to Ty Hers registered, and also to make enquiries about getting it valued for insurance purposes (together with other council assets such as the bus stops and telephone boxes). (ii) To note that bits of masonry were falling off the Railway Bridge and the suggestion that better notices were needed about the height limit. There was uncertainty about whether this was the responsibility of the Gwili Railway or the County Council. It was suggested that individual
