Superfast Broadband – or should it be Superslow?

Alternative uses for Grit Bins

If somebody offered you one, what would you use it for? Obviously they have been designed to contain salt laden grit and the bins are situated at strategic places on country lanes where the gritting lorry doesn't get to so that hills and sharp bends can be kept relatively ice free and safer for traffic. Llanpumsaint Community Council had requested of the County Highways Department that a Grit Bin be placed on the bend opposite the entrance to Pantydriw as there is often seepage of water out of the hedge and onto the road and when the temperature drops below freezing, the sharp turn in the road can be extremely dangerous early in the morning because the bend is sheltered from the rising sun and it is an icy road surface that doesn't thaw until mid morning, some considerable time after the school bus has inched its way down the hill. Last Autumn, the Highways Dept granted us our wish and placed a Bin filled with grit in a location convenient for the grit to be applied to the road when needed. For some unknown reason, approximately a month ago, the Grit Bin disappeared and its contents tipped onto the road; the cheerful, yellow box had barely settled in before it was moved (probably against its will!) and the Councillors would like to know to where!

According to Tony Williams of Highways, theft of Grit Bins is very rare; usually it is the contents that disappear and not the Bin but someone passing through the village took a fancy to the large moulded plastic box and removed it and the community would like to have it returned please! It does this in three ways:-

- BT Blacklist - BT have their identified a blacklist of nuisance callers, and any call from these numbers will be sent to your junk voicemail by default when you sign up for BT Call Protect.
- Personal Blacklist – You can add the last call you answered to your own blacklist, so that in future any calls from those numbers also go junk voicemail.
- You can also add calls from certain categories to your junk mail as well, such as International, and Withheld numbers if you want.

You manage all settings from your home phone by dialling 1572, free call.

‘we see that you have problems with your hub that are putting your computer/laptop/tablet at risk. Please turn on your computer and let me help you to correct the faults’

Stop them there – do not let them have access to your equipment. They are not from BT, just put the phone down (and if you have signed up for Call Protect, log the number on you personal blacklist, even if it is an international or withheld number). Stag & Pheasant and Revolution

Now a private residence this former Public House sits quietly at the junction of the road towards Bronwydd, off the main Carmarthen to Lampeter highway in the village of Pontarsais, some halfway between Rhydargaeau and Alltwalis. Originally part of Llanllawddog's Glangwili Estate its name reveals an ancient hunting related pedigree. During the early 20th century the Landlord, Sam Isaac, also served as the driver of the Coach & Four for the Estate's privileged family. For decades it remained a quiet unassuming country pub!

Then abruptly in 1961, there was a sudden and dramatic change of atmosphere and fortune, as new Landlady Mrs Madge Jenkins arrived from Tresaith near Aberporth. It became exceptionally full and busy, as two pretty girls, Olga and Enfys, served pints flat out to excited youngsters. We were right in the middle of that Sixties Revolution, as a fresh generation flexed their new found freedoms, to challenge the traditional old ways of living and thinking. Looking back historically one can detect a number of factors which contributed to this exceptional phenomenon, reflected so vividly at the Stag & Pheasant.

By the Sixties, as Post-War gloom and thrift receded, rural life and farming prospered enough to see motor-cars arrive on farmyards. When eldest sons passed Driving Tests and inherited pocket money, it became natural to borrow the family car on a Saturday night. Officially they were off to a Concert or an Eisteddfod, the latter proving to become a convenient excuse for arriving back home so late from somewhere else. Off they'd go, to over-fill the seats with favoured friends! First stop - The Stag – then Carmarthen Barracks Dance – then Chips – then Eisteddfod – and hopefully girlfriend. It accelerated in so many villages around, to overflow a packed Stag car-park. They came from all over Carmarthenshire and then Ceredigion and beyond.

Why the Stag, you could ask? Most traditional Landlords eyed these youngsters rather warily - *"They're into that Rock & Roll -- dancing wildly to that Bill Haley nonsense -- And those Beatles with funny hair and silly trousers -- And now they've started shouting about the Language and things -- Believe me they're nothing but trouble!* But Madge Jenkins was different, not your conventional middle aged mother, content with Chapel, W.I. and jam. Underneath that welcoming smile and mischievous laugh lurked an astute business woman, who realised that here we had a new generation seeking a place to meet, a welcome and a home from home. She provided exactly that!

That Sixties generation awoke politically as well. An awareness of Human Rights stirred to become an issue, and the plight of the Welsh Language became highlighted. Soon The Stag evolved as a centre for Language activists as the battle for bilingual road signs boiled over. You'd see three half empty pints, ownerless for some twenty minutes, then they were back! Next morning *To Carmarthen* and *To Lampeter* would have changed colour to green.

The destruction and drowning of the Tryweryn community in North Wales triggered the Free Wales Army into action. They found the Stag & Pheasant a convenient watering hole on their journeys between the North and South. Caio Evans, Dennis Coslett and co, despite some bizarre activities, found considerable support amongst those opposed to traditional servile attitudes, particularly over the Investiture issue. Madge's hearty welcome was extended to all and there never was any trouble at the Stag. When some customers were hauled before courts for political charges, she'd be there in the public gallery in support of her customers.. A young lad entered the Lounge to strum a guitar and sing novel songs – Mike Stevens had arrived – soon destined to become a national icon – but remain a friend to the Jenkins family henceforth. Then Heather Jones sang, as did Dewi Pws, and in the end anyone who was anybody in the music scene of the period called and

performed. Bards pulled in regularly and Archdruid Dic Jones composed a special verse to the place.

In the end it became so packed out, Darts boys, Dai Twm and Philbo, squeezed in a corner and piano playing Percy submerged beneath bellowing bodies, that an extension became inevitable. But still there was always that post Stop-Tap invitation into the kitchen, where she prepared free sandwiches with that extra free-bee one for the road. All things come to an end and so did this era. In 1972 Madge and family moved on to Aberystwyth where she lived to a ripe old age of 95, before passing away in 2017. So the Stag & Pheasant reverted to being a conventional pub once more. Things changed for that Sixties generation too! Soon youngsters came to afford their own car and became more independent, so that squeezed in the back seat close knit little society, receded forever. You went your own way from now on! Human Rights got a hearing, and the Language was allowed more respect, as Bilingual signs added Caerfyrddin and Llanbedr Pont- Steffen to the roadside.

That unconventional open hearted lady of the infectious laugh, who became mother to those revolutionary children of the Sixties, was unique. Madge Stag!
