A hundred and fiftieth Birthday

On the twelfth of January 2013 Llanpumsaint School will celebrate having been open for 150 years. Way back in 1933 the first Reunion of former pupils saw 500 invitations go out to former pupils who'd attended between 1863 and 1912. After revisiting their classrooms they enjoyed a sumptuous tea at the Memorial Hall and pledged to erect a Memorial plaque to the founder William Williams, Tredarren farm, at the school. This time former pupils who attended up to 1972 are organising another Reunion, which will happen on 23rd March 2013. On that Saturday past pupils will be invited back to class to view some modern teaching techniques, before proceeding once more to the Memorial Hall to enjoy tea. At the Hall there will be an exhibition of photographs and memorabilia to help jog those memories and enrich the reminiscing. That exhibition will be open to the public at another time.

Work has already begun to publish a booklet of reminiscences up to 1972, which will include some of the background history of the School. Evidence has already been collected from around twenty of the oldest ex-pupils, who were there during the 1920s and 1930s under Mr Johns. We appeal to all those who attended during the later years to contribute any stories, recollections or photographs, so that a comprehensive record is produced. We are now particularly interested in the following periods –

Mr Edwin Pugh (1948-1956), Mr Cyril Treharne (1956-1964), Mr Arnallt Owen (1964-1972), Mr Len Richards (1972)

In order to meet publication deadlines all evidence must be collected by the 10th of November 2012.

Details of the celebrations planned by the school to mark the event will follow in the next editions of the Village Voice.

Do you like your E-Mails with Spam or Scam? (If you use E-Mails, read on.)

So many of us depend on E-Mails these days, it makes you wonder where the beauty of the written word on old-fashioned paper has gone. However, as the future moves on, many of us have no choice but to use the Internet for correspondence, searching for information, from the weather to cooking recipes to holidays to reviews about everyday purchases, and even filling out on-line forms.

But, we have to be wary of the pesky rogues out there who prey on us all. You must have had the occasional Scam E-Mail (a fraud) or is your poison, Spam (junk mail)?

Of course, there is software out there, free and purchased, which will control unwanted Mail, but increasingly, the rogues get better than the software and get through to your PC. Scam E-Mails are quite easy to deal with. If it appears to be too good to be true, then it **is** too good to be true. So do not reply to it. Examples are, "Bank" requesting you to update your details including PIN. Every so often, the recipient will be a customer of the "Bank" and reply, resulting in fraudulent withdrawal of cash. Or the foreign gentleman who unfortunately needs to dispose of £50M and needs your help. Just delete it.

Spam is normally junk mail and as any other junk you find, throw it away. But, do not reply or ask to be removed. Spam is almost always, automatically generated by a rogue PC and if it receives a response, it knows that the Mail is genuine and sends you even more. Some malicious code may even infect your PC and make it a rogue machine which sends Spam Mails to your friends in your Contact lists. So, just delete it.

Your Mail is collected on a Server, owned by organisations such as Yahoo, Google, BT, Virgin etc. You collect it either by signing on to the Server, either directly or via propriety software such as Outlook or Windows Live Mail. A short while ago, one of the Server owners, incorrectly marked some Mails as Spam and blocked it at their Server. This meant that you did not get the Mail and of course did not know that it was missing. If you use propriety software to receive your Mails, it usually has the ability to re-direct unwanted Mail to a separate folder. This means that you can have a peak at what is in there and delete them all. However, it still means that you receive it, which can be a nuisance. If you have the ability to sign on to the Server, then you can normally set up your own rules there and stop the mail getting through to your PC. This is what the Server owner incorrectly did and hence, the lack of mail to users.

If you are unsure about some mail, copy a portion, the Subject line is sometimes good enough. Paste it into a search engine, and see if you get a match. Good places to check are www.snopes.com and www.hoax-slayer.com. They tell you all about the mail if it's been seen already. Most are old and re-sent over the years.

So, be aware, be safe, and don't let the intruders get you.

Dog Fouling and Litter

We have been asked to put an item in Village voice about dog fouling – and to ask if people walking their dogs could actually place their bags of dog poo in the litter bins around the village or take them home. Whilst many dog walkers do dispose of the bags properly, there are some that leave bags of dog poo on bridge parapets and hanging in hedges. If you are walking your dogs along the roads in or leading into the village, please bag up the dog mess and bin it or take it home, and ensure that the grass verges do not become dog toilets.

Residents in Llanpumsaint are being urged to help the council tackle dog fouling. A Dog Watch scheme has been launched to encourage people to report offences. Local people often know who the offenders are, and can help tackle the problem of dog fouling in their area, by reporting them to the council. Environmental enforcement officers can then follow up reported offences and target areas of greatest complaint.

Anyone caught failing to pick up after their dog can be issued with a fixed penalty notice of £75 or face prosecution in court and a maximum fine of £1,000. And if you don't dispose of the bag of dog poo in a bin, then you could be fined for littering, and be issued with a fixed penalty notice for £75. You can also be prosecuted in court where the maximum fine that can be imposed by magistrates is £2,500.

Executive Board Member for Environmental and Public Protection Cllr Jim Jones said: “One of the main reasons that dog owners don't clear up after their dog is because they think there is not a council officer watching. However, if the message gets out that the general public can take direct action to report offences, dog owners are far more likely to behave responsibly.”

And remember, if you drop any litter or throw it out of your car, you can end up picking up a fine, up to £2500 if the case is taken to the magistrate's court.

Village Weather! By our weatherwise correspondent

Hmmm, 'it might as well rain until September' eh; that might have been tempting providence, because September came and went and was wet throughout. It's strange how expectations change; in May we would have said, 'it'll be great to have some sunny weather in June' but by now we'd be happy with, 'just let it not rain, I don't care whether the sun shines or skies are blue, just let it not rain'! With Team GB winning medals and breaking records in the Olympics, UK weather has done the same with the East of England's drought being the wettest ever and June rainfall at 2.5 times the average being an all time record. Athletes can be encouraged to train hard so as to break more records but we would prefer our weather to return to how it was.....

Almost miraculously, farmers have been able to harvest grass, mostly as silage but some farmers have been able to make hay; however too great a proportion of the winter feed has already been consumed by cattle during the summer, which leaves a shortfall of fodder for the winter and already some farmers are selling livestock because they know that there will not be enough silage to feed them throughout the winter and what silage and hay will become available at farm sales etc, will be prohibitively expensive. What could be worse than a wet summer that just goes on and on – a dry summer! If we were to experience a drought for as long as we have had rain, the consequences would be ruinous; at least grass has grown with all of this moisture. The 12 weeks without any rain in 1976 was far more damaging and its consequences longer lasting, with ground water levels taking several years to return to their normal levels. This summer has probably finally topped them up.....
